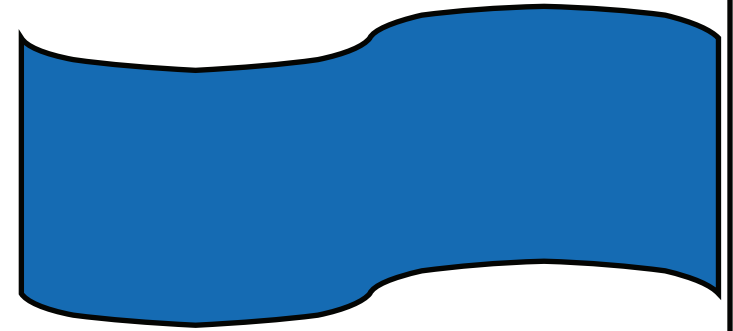

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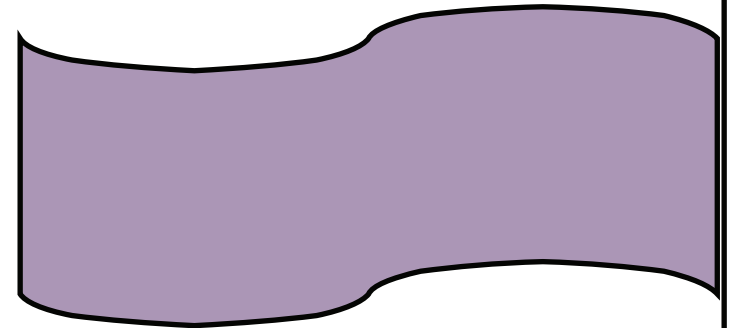
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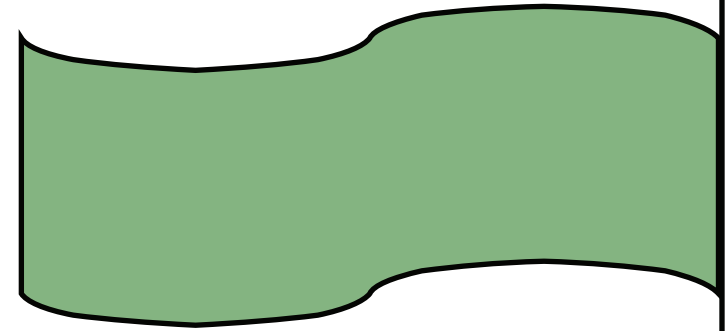


Here is a 5 dollar bill.

It is purple.

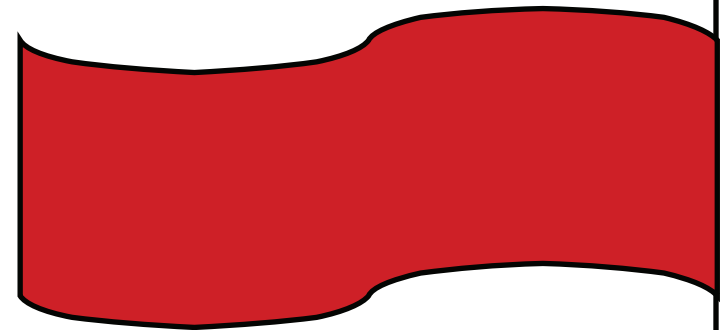


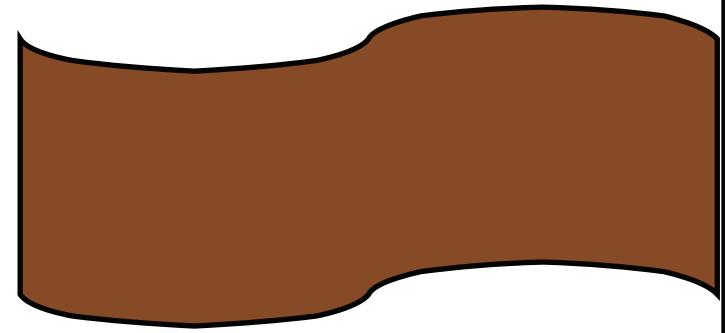


Here is a 20 dollar bill.
